My Script:

Introduction:

Hello everyone, my name is Ella and in this video I'm going to be teaching you how to play the card game solitaire. I love playing cards as a way to unwind after school but still be stimulating my brain so this game is perfect because you can play solo!

What you will need:

For this game all you need is one deck of regular old cards!

Dealing the game:

To deal out the game you will make seven columns of cards with the first column on the left having one card facing upward. You follow that column by putting one face down in all the other six columns. Then flip a card face up on the second pile and continue by putting five more face down in the remaining columns. Repeat this step till there is one more face down card behind the face up one in every pile and place the remaining cards face down in a pile above.


Playing the game:




To play this game you place cards that are a lower number and different colour on top of each other. Any ace that you find can be placed above and those piles are made of the same suit and increasing in number. When you have no moves in your seven column piles you may flip one over from the pile of remaining cards above. You continue this until either all the cards are placed in the pile of aces above or you are out of moves and you win or lose.
